The information on the emblem is prioritised in order of importance in an emergency care situation by our medically trained team.


Helps with Diagnosis

24/7 Emergency Support Line

Additional medical information and contact details are available on the 24/7 emergency contact number, as well as copies of the legal document to support an advance decision. This provides invaluable medical history to aid your initial diagnosis.

For a MedicAlert® emblem on the pulse points

1. Check Patient

Check all patients for a MedicAlert® emblem. This will most often be found near their pulse point (wrist or neck). There are a range of styles and they all clearly display the international medical symbol on the front.



2. Read Emblem

If you find an emblem, turn it over to read the medical information on the reverse. This is where the member's most critical medical conditions are engraved.



3. Call Our 24/7 Emergency Support

Every emblem has our 24/7 emergency response telephone number (+44 (0)20 7407 2818), and the personal membership number for the patient. This provides instant access to additional medical and personal information.
